Mr. Garrick presented an information in this case, and stated that Wheeler was out on Bail.

Wheeler was then called three times at the door of the Court, ^{on his recognizance} but did not appear.

Mr. Garrick asked to have the recognizances of Wheeler and his sureties executed.

Order accordingly.

I am manager of the Coorena Station - I know the pris^r - I become ^{acquainted} with both pris^r at the last & was races at Aramac. This Skuthorpe rode a horse of Roberts - After the races I saw the pris^r at the Alice river in Jan^y last.

The Skuthorpe Bros. had a station called "Mexico" - That station is on the Alice River - I did not see the pris^r between Blackall and Aramac - They were camped on the Alice river when I saw them.
