I am manager of the
Coreena Station - I know
the prisnr[?] - I became acquainted with
both prisnrs at the last Xmas[?]
races at Aramac - Prisnr Skulthorpe

rode a horse of Roberts' - After
the races I saw the prisnrs at the Alice river in Janry last[?]

The Skulthorpe Bros. had a station
called "Mexico" - that station is on
the Alice River - I did not see the
prisnrs between Blackall and
Aramac - They were camped on
the Alice River when I saw them -
