Dear Sir,

As you are aware, the Government of Queensland pays insurance-premiums and Superannuation-deductions, of those members of the Police Force who are granted permission to join the Expeditionary Forces for oversea-service, i.e., whilst their military pay does not exceed that which they would draw as members of the Police Force.

It has been difficult to determine when the latter contingency arises, and it would not be reasonable to expect the men themselves to advise all their promotions and movements, etc. Your assistance in this connection is therefore sought, and would be of great value to me, apart from the matter of the payments referred to, as advice from you would keep me posted in the doings of some of my men, in whose careers I take a great interest.

I am enclosing lists of members of the Police Force who left the service to go to the Front, and whose superannuation and insurance-payments are being defrayed by this department, and I should be very much obliged if you would keep me informed of any promotions, amongst their number, from the rank of Private, together with the consequent rates of military pay, in order that necessary adjustments in this office may be made from time to time. Should any of these men have attained the rank of Corporal, or Sergeant, or higher, perhaps you can advise me at once.

It would be also of help if you would have me

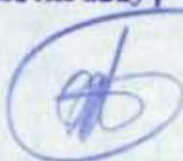
