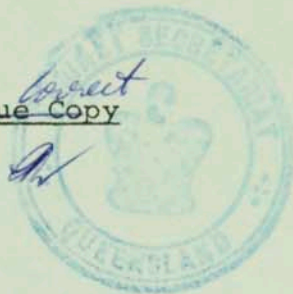
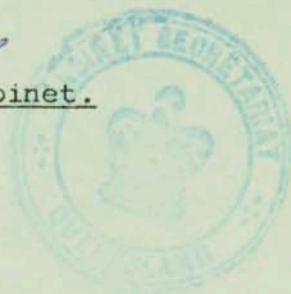

TITLE: Disposal of the Former Moorang
State School Site.

CABINET decided:-

That the approval of the Governor in Council be sought for action to be taken under Section 9A of the Education Act 1964-1984 to dispose of the site of the former Moorang State School by sale and pay the proceeds of the sale into Consolidated Revenue.

FOR CABINETDISPOSAL OF THE FORMER MOORANG STATE SCHOOL SITE

1. The Moorang State School was closed as from 31 December 1920. All building improvements have been removed from the site.
2. The school site was originally donated for school purposes by James English Junior in 1891. It contains an area of .809 ha. (2 acres).
3. The site is described as Subdivision 2 of Portion 67 Parish of Rosevale County of Churchill and located near Rosewood.
4. There is now no effective method of using the site directly to meet the wishes of the donor.
5. Section 9A of the Education Act 1964-1984 provides for the disposal of land donated for educational purposes, the use of such purposes being no longer practicable. It provides for the Governor-in-Council to direct that such land shall

be used or sold freed and discharged from all trusts, if any, to which it or they are or may be subject, and the proceeds of the sale applied or used for such purposes of the Department as the Governor-in-Council shall direct

or

be reconveyed to the donor, or should the donor not be living at the time in question, be conveyed to such person or persons as the Governor-in-Council may direct.

6. A claim for the site was made by Mr W.J. English in 1978, however he has been unsuccessful in his attempts to provide legal documentation to support his claim for conveyance of the site.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT:

Approval of the Governor-in-Council be sought for action to be taken under Section 9A of the Education Act 1964-1984 to dispose of the site of the former Moorang State School by sale and pay the proceeds of the sale into Consolidated Revenue.
