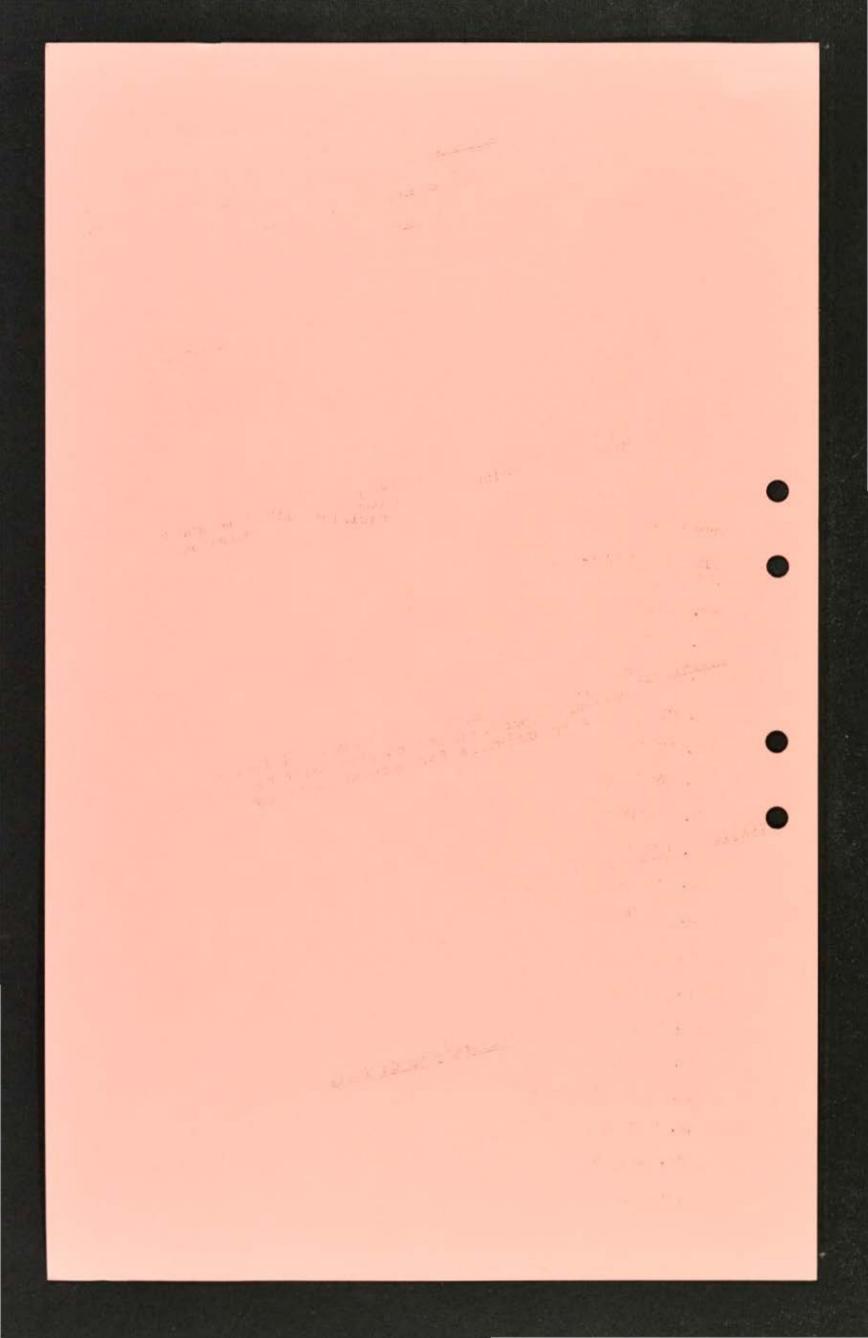

RE: UNFORESEEN EXPENDITURE 1985-86

A review of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and Trust and Special Fund Estimates for the Department of Education indicates that amounts provided under certain votes will be insufficient to meet anticipated expenditure to 30th June, 1986 and will require Unforeseen Expenditure as per Appendix "A".

The Unforeseen Expenditure in the Trust and Special Funds will be funded from additional monies received from the Commonwealth and receipts in excess of original expectations.

The excess expenditure in the Consolidated Revenue Fund will be offset by additional Commonwealth funds or by savings in other Revenue votes for State funded projects. Additional State Consolidated Revenue Funds will not be required. The use of savings within State funded areas has been discussed with and agreed to by Treasury Department.
