DISPOSAL OF THE FORMER CLAYTON STATE SCHOOL SITE

- 1. The Clayton State School closed on 31 December 1971. All building improvements have been removed.
- 2. The school site was originally donated for school purposes by Mrs Ernestina Julia Sarah Natzke in 1930. It contains an area of 2.023 hectares and is described as Portion 203, Parish of Bundaberg, County of Cook. The location is near Bundaberg.
- 3. There is now no effective method of using the site directly to meet the wishes of the donor.
- 4. Section 9A of the Education Act 1964-1988 provides for the disposal of lands donated for school or other education purposes, the use for such purposes being no longer practicable. It provides that such land shall be reconveyed to the donor or, should the donor not be living at the time in question, be conveyed to such person or persons as the Governor in Council may direct.
- 5. A claim was received from Mrs Ernestina Crank, daughter and sole beneficiary of her mother's will. A claim was received from Mr A.F. Natzke and Mr E.A. Natzke, grandsons of the donor. However, they are not beneficiaries under the will of Mrs Natzke.
- 6. Mrs Ernestina Crank died on 3 August 1988. The Public Trustee, who is administering the estate, has requested that the land be transferred to the Public Trustee as personal representative of Ernestina Crank.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT:

The approval of the Governor in Council be sought for action to be taken under section 9A of the Education Act 1964-1988 for the site of the former Clayton State School to be conveyed to the Public Trustee as personal representative of Ernestina Crank.
