REWARD FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO RECAPTURE  
OF SIX PRISON ESCAPEES

1. On 11 March 1989, the following prisoners escaped from the Brisbane Correctional Centre and are still at large:-

Leslie CONNOLLY  
Ian David HUNTER  
Brett Travis LANGFORD  
Wayne Michael RYAN  
Vincenzo SANGRICOLI  
Bart Hans VOSMAER

All of the above are considered dangerous.

2. It is alleged that a previous escapee, namely Francis Gordon POST, is acting in collusion with these persons. Advice has been received by me from a member of the public that an armed attack will be made on one of our prisons by Post and his associates with a view to releasing prisoners.
3. General Managers of all prisons and the Acting Commissioner of Police have been warned of a possible attack and appropriate measures have been taken.
4. By Decision No. 55254 of 3 October 1988, Cabinet agreed to a reward of \$10,000 for information leading to the recapture of Francis Gordon POST.
5. It is appropriate that a similar reward now be made for information leading to the recapture of these six escapees.

6. I RECOMMEND that a reward of \$10,000 each be paid for information leading to the recapture of these six prisoners.
