Whereas an International Health Exhibition is to be held in the City of London
during the present year, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-four. And it hath appeared to us
to be expedient to appoint Commissioners to act on behalf of Our Colony of Queensland in all things
connected with the aforesaid Exhibition. Now, therefore, Know ye, that we of Our Special Grace have
thought fit to appoint and we do hereby appoint you the said Agent General for Our said Colony
in London and you the said John Douglas Esquire, to be Commissioners for Our said Colony of
Queensland to represent Our said Colony at the said Exhibition and to manage and conduct
all such matters and things as may be necessary to be managed or conducted on behalf of Our
said Colony in relation to the said Exhibition or to things which may be entrusted to your charge
for Exhibition thereof. And we do hereby require you to report to the Government of Our said
Colony under your hands what you shall do in the premises.
