By virtue of the Power in Us vested we do hereby
direct that an Election be held for the return of three members
to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Our said Colony for the
Electoral District of Westmoreton and that the nomination
for such Election be held at Ipswich on the 25th day of June
1867 and in the event of such Election being contested the Poll
at the several Polling Places for the said Electoral District be
taken on Thursday the 2nd day of July and we do further
direct that you certify under your hand by endorsement
on this Our Writ the names of the members who shall be
elected and that you cause this Our Writ with such
Certificate endorsed thereon, to be returned to us at
Brisbane on the 30th day of July 1867

Our Colony of Queensland to be affixed to this Our Writ
