

An Inquest of death held upon
the body of Ah lung deceased
at Huston Creek on May 22nd
1872 before Amos H. George D. J. P. M.

Ah hee being duly sworn by blowing
out a match says my name is
Ah loee, I am a Miner & reside at
Huston Creek, I knew the deceased.
Ah loee, yesterday about 10 o'clock
in the morning I was looking for
horses, I saw a man hanging
from a tree, I called Ah Sam, we
went to the tree and Ah Sam cut
the rope, we looked & saw the man
was dead, I then told my countrymen
in the Township - the body I now see
is the body of Ah lung ^{his}

Ah Sam being duly sworn says my
name is Ah Sam I am a Miner &
reside on Huston Creek, yesterday
Ah loee called me & said he wanted
me to make life in a man, I say
I can't make life, I called the
Butcher & I cut the rope, I saw
the deceased man hanging from a
tree, he was dead, the body I now
see is the body I saw hanging

Francis Faulkner being duly
sworn says my name is
Francis Faulkner, I am a
Serivour Constable in the
Dundalk Police & Station
at Westmunk on yesterday
morning 21st inst about 10
o'clock I received information
that a Chinaman had
hanged himself in a gully
close to the Iron ship I proceeded
to the place in company of Ah boy.
I saw the body of deceased
lying on the ground & a piece
of rope about 18 inches long
round his neck, he was quite
dead, there was a deep
black mark round his neck.
I searched the body & found
a leather belt & pouch & a
Chamisso bag in the pouch
there was nothing in it.
I knew the man Ah boy for some
time, I knew he was of unsound
mind but apparently not dangerous
to himself or others, he was never
violent to my knowledge, his country
men took care of him, I then
sent information to the Police
Magistrate.
